



The campaign on World Rabies Day in Thailand has been organized since 2007 with the collaborations of 6 concerned agencies, including Department of Disease Control, Department of Livestock Development, Bureau of Health (Bangkok Metropolitan), Faculty of Medicine (Chulalongkorn University), Faculty of Veterinary Medicine (Mahidol University), and Queen Saovabha Memorial Institute (Thai Red Cross Society).

This year, World Rabies Day 2015 campaign was held on 24 September 2015. The objectives of the event were to create understanding and to raise awareness among Thai people on the goal of eliminating rabies in Thailand within 2020. In the campaign, there were many prevention and control rabies activities including:

- Exhibitions and activities to create understanding about rabies prevention and control,
- Pet (dog and cat) handling show,
- Mobile units were established across the country for rabies vaccination and neutering services in dogs and cats as well as consultation and advice on pet care and responsible ownership.
