Special Announcement of COVID-19 On 28 May 2020

Regarding today's COVD-19 situation in Thailand, 14 cases recovered and were discharged (a total of 2,945 cases have recovered or 96.08% of the total number of the confirmed cases) and 63 were being treated in hospitals (2.06% of the total number of confirmed cases). Today, 11 new COVID-19 cases were confirmed (six confirmed cases who returned from Qatar, four confirmed cases who returned from Kuwait, and one confirmed case who returned from India) and they were all under state quarantine. This brought the total number of cases to 3,065. The total number of deaths remained at 57. There were no reports of deaths today.

From the report of the new confirmed cases today, the main cause was found in the people who entered the country from abroad by aircraft and ground crossing points. To protect the population from local transmission, the government assigned the relevant partners to manage these groups. All Thai citizens must be observed in the designated places for 14 days free of charge and there is no commission from the operator in any way. For people who are willing to stay in an Alternative State Quarantine area, they are responsible for their own expenses, both of which have terms and conditions: they must have health care management, be under the supervision of medical personnel, and must also be tested twice. If they are sick, they will be sent to receive health treatment immediately.

On 28 May 2020, there will be flights bringing 400 Thai citizens (undergraduate and graduate students, monks and remaining Thai tourists from abroad) from Vietnam, Australia, and the United States back to Thailand.
