Special Announcement of COVID-19 On 24 April 2020

On 23 April 2020 at 4.00 p.m., 60 cases in Thailand recovered and were discharged (a total of 2,490 cases or 87.25% of the total number of confirmed cases have been discharged), 314 were being treated in hospitals (11% of the total number of confirmed cases), and there have been 50 fatal cases. The total number of confirmed cases is 2,854. For today, 15 new COVID-19 cases were confirmed (the 2,840th - 2,854th cases), which include:

The first group: Nine cases who had a history of close contact with previous cases. (The cases were found in Phuket, Songkhla, and Bangkok).

The second group: Two additional confirmed cases with the details as follows:

- 2.1 One confirmed case who returned from abroad (returned from The United States on 31 March 2020).
- 2.2 One confirmed case who had travel history to crowded places including shopping malls, market places or tourist places.

Four of the confirmed cases were found by active case finding in Yala province.

(Remark: No reports among healthcare workers for the last 6 days). Today, there was no reported death.

From 5 January to 24 April 2020 (as of 07:00 a.m.), There have been 2,715,614 confirmed cases and 190,422 deaths worldwide. The three countries reporting the most cases include the United States with 879,430 confirmed cases and 49,769 deaths, Spain with 213,024 confirmed cases and 22,157 deaths, and the Italian Republic with 189,973 confirmed cases and 25,549 deaths.
