Special Announcement of COVID-19 On 26 April 2020

On 2,5 April 2020 as of 4.00 p.m., 47 cases in Thailand recovered and were discharged (a total of 2,594 cases or 87.77% of the total number of the confirmed cases), 277 were being treated in hospitals (9.48% of the total number of confirmed cases), and there have been 51 fatal cases. Today, 15 new COVID-19 cases (the 2,908th - 2,922th cases) were confirmed which brings the total number of confirmed cases to 2,922 which include:

- 1. Four cases who had a history of close contact with previous cases. (The cases were found in Phuket).
- 2. Three confirmed cases who had travel history to crowded places including shopping malls, market places or tourist places
- 3. One confirmed case who had occupational risks (a public transport driver)
- 4. Two confirmed cases were found by active case finding in Yala province.
- 5. Five confirmed cases were reported in the State quarantine areas (4 cases who returned from The United Arab Emirates and be quarantined in Bangkok, 1 case who returned from Netherland and be quarantined in Chonburi province)

(Remark: There were no reports of cases among healthcare workers for the last 8 days). Today, there were no reports of deaths.

From 5 January to 26 April 2020 (as of 07:00 a.m.), There have been 2,920,738 confirmed cases and 203,355 deaths worldwide. The three countries reporting the most cases include the United States with 960,651 confirmed cases and 54,256 deaths, Spain with 223,759 confirmed cases and 22,902 deaths, and the Italian Republic with 195,351 confirmed cases and 26,384 deaths
