## 3. Thailand Precautions

 The Minister of Digital Economy and Society (DES) opened the Smart Pier Model project by developing a port management at Ao Por Pier in Phuket. From this project, the province will have useful information, number of passengers in each ship, and video records with passenger temperature screening before embarking on the boat. The information and screening facilities will be useful for passenger safety, screening and monitoring of disease epidemics.

#### 4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

The number of new cases of COVID-19 in Thailand today is stable. Most of the infected people were overseas travelers who stayed in State Quarantine facilities and some were those found from the screening efforts at the border areas. New cases had no symptoms. However, Thailand had found 2 cases who had never traveled out of the country during the past 3 months. This could indicate local transmissions which need further close investigation and monitoring.
