3. Thailand Precautions

• The Ministry of Public Health had planned to reduce the quarantine period for those who came from low risk or equal risk countries from 14 to 10 days. Still, the travellers need to get the COVID-19 test prior to travelling and pass through the screening process upon arrival. They are required as well to get the 3 PCR tests and 2 immunity blood tests during the quarantine. And after finishing the quarantine, there will be a 4 daily tracking using the wristband or application which will be monitored by the officers. Travellers who develop suspicious symptoms of illness will be sent to the hospitals and be responsible for the treatment expenses.

4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

Today, almost all COVID-19 confirmed cases are found at the designated quarantine places, both the Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) and the Alternative Hospital Quarantine (AHQ). The number of these cases tend to be increasing due to the policy to receive tourists especially medical tourism.
