### 3. Thailand Precautions

- The Ministry of Public Health forecasted the COVID-19 situation in Thailand in three scenarios that will occur in the next phase, i.e. 1) **Spike** (Well controlled): one or two cases and no spreading (such as the case of the DJ prisoner and the French woman in Koh Samui) 2) **Spike with Small Wave** (Rapidly controlled): after the first patient, a small outbreak with 10 - 20 cases occurs then is rapidly controlled within less than 3 - 4 weeks (such as the infection people in Mae Sot district, Tak province), and 3) **Spike with Big Wave** (Delayed controlled): when the first case occurs, the disease is spread widely to 100 - 200 cases (such as the boxing arena outbreak).

#### 4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

During the past week, 52 COVID-19 patients were found of whom 98 percent were travellers from overseas. The concerned situation in Myanmar had been now decreasing while the numbers in European countries especially Russia, France, United Kingdom, and Italy are increasing. Hence, there is the need to strengthen strict screening or even suspend entering of passengers from these countries.
