3. Thailand Precautions

- Maesot District Hospital, Tak province, revealed that public governance officials, military
 officials and involved agencies arrested 11 Thais at Ban Mahawan, Mahawan subdistrict,
 Maesot district. The public health coordinators carried out the screening and found that one
 out of 11 persons had high fever and PCR result is awaiting. The officials have requested
 the people's cooperation for help on the surveillance and hotel or homestay owners to
 screen all guests.
- The Deputy Governor of Phuket province, Director of Phuket International Airport, Head of the Passport Office, and President of Phuket Tourism Association welcomed the Ambassadors and their spouses from 15 countries who participated in the Ambassador's Trip to Phuket 2020 program. Upon arrival at the airport, they will receive a briefing on screening measures for the Special Tourist VISA group including tourists and business persons according to the government policy. The measures will be performed by the International Communicable Disease Control Checkpoint officers. The passengers will receive body temperature screening, relevant history check, registration, SARS-CoV-2 test, and laboratory sample collection. The Ambassadors' group are scheduled to travel to Phuket during 14 - 16 November.

4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

During the past one month (15 October to 15 November), there were an average of 2,013 persons per day screened for COVID-19. The detection rate was 0.34 percent. When compared to the previous one month (15 September to 15 October) there were 1,508 persons per day screened and the detection rate was 0.40 percent. This showed that the detection rates have not increased despite the increasing trend reported abroad. However, continuous surveillance has to be actively implemented.
