3. Thailand Precautions

The Operational Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (OCCSA), with the Secretary of the National Security Council as the Director of Centre, has approved the extension enforcement period of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation, B.E. 2548 for another 45 days (1 December 2020 to 15 January 2021). Moreover, the OCCSA will also submit a proposal to reduce the quarantine period from 14 days to 10 days for traveling attraction and economic relief. The proposal has to be submitted to the CCSA chaired by General Prayut Chan-o-cha, Prime Minister, to consider for approval.

4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

On 16 November 2020, Thailand found the first COVID-19 case in a 3 weeks period. The case had the history of traveling from Japan on 29 October 2020. It was found that Japan has been currently facing the 3rd wave of the pandemic. Most of the towns with a high number of reported COVID-19 cases are those important travel destinations. This may be due to the policy measures to reopen the towns to receive tourists for economic relief. So, Thailand may have an increasing risk of finding more cases who have a history of traveling from Japan.
