3. Thailand Precautions

The Department of Health, Ministry of Public Health, reported the "Health Pole" survey results on self-protective behaviors of people across the country during the first phase of the COVID-19 pandemic that more than 90 percent were aware of mask wearing regularly. However, the latest survey on 13 November 2020 among the 12,842 people has shown that the behavior of wearing masks has decreased to be 85 percent. Moreover, 77 percent of these people wear masks all the time when they are in shopping malls, hospitals, and convenience stores, while only 52 - 54 percent wear masks all the time when they are in sport stadiums, parks, or tourist attractions such as national parks or beaches.

4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

Today, 37.5 percent of new COVID-19 cases were those showing symptoms detected at the airport screening. However, most of the new cases were detected from laboratory testing among the asymptomatic people traveling from abroad and stayed both at the State Quarantine (SQ) and Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) places. This showed that both the symptomatic screening and the asymptomatic screening among people traveling from abroad remains important measures for rapid case detection and prompt prevention of the disease spread.
