### 3. Thailand Precautions

- Spokesperson, Office of the Prime Minister, revealed resolutions of the weekly Cabinet meeting on November 17, 2020 that the cabinet approved 3,670,292,517 THB budget for advanced reservation of 26 million doses of COVID 19 vaccine (for 13 million people) with AstraZeneca (Thailand) Co.,Ltd. and AstraZeneca UK Co.,Ltd. The implementation period will be from November 2020 to December 2021. The vaccination will help reduce both the morbidity and mortality as well as the government budget spending for treatment and care of COVID-19 patients. Based upon the successful vaccine development, Thailand will be among the first countries that have access to the vaccines. In addition, the production technology will also be transferred so that the vaccine can be produced locally.

## 4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

During 13 -19 November 2020, most of the COVID-19 cases detected were those in the age group 30 - 49 years (minimum 19 years, maximum 76 years). The top three countries of origin with the highest number of infected cases entering Thailand were the United Kingdom, India and Switzerland. Most of them (90.9%) were found by the first specimen collection for laboratory diagnosis.
