3. Thailand Precautions

- The Department of Diseases Control (DDC) coordinated with Grabtaxi (Thailand) Co., Ltd. following detection of the latest COVID-19 new case in Chiang Mai province to request cooperation for tracking of the traveling history data to identify the Grab driver who had contact with the COVID-19 case including all customers who had contacts with the driver. All had received SAR-CoV-2 laboratory investigation at the hospital and are now under quarantine.
- Chiang Rai Governor stated about the investigation that the 2 COVID -19 cases smuggled through natural crossing paths from Myanmar and stayed in the hotel without leaving the accommodation until visiting the doctor. The disease Investigation team had searched and found 26 - 30 high and low-risk contacts. All of them had been tested for SAR-CoV-2 and quarantined. The Provincial Governor requested the public to follow strict preventive measures.

4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

According to the continued detection of COVID-19 Thai cases traveled back from Myanmar through natural border paths in Chiang Mai and Chiang Rai which corresponds to the COVID-19 situation in Myanmar in which more than 1,500 COVID-19 cases are reported per day. This indicates that not only Chiang Mai and Chiang Rai that are at risk of the disease but also provinces that share borders with Myanmar and provinces which are the destinations of migrant workers who illegally smuggle into Thailand. These provinces must closely monitor their borders and perform active surveillance including laboratory testing of patients with respiratory symptoms as well as checking the travel history of these patients.
