#### 3. Thailand Precautions

- Mr. Anutin Charnvirakul, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Public Health, ordered the
  Director of the Office of Disease Prevention and Control 1 (ODPC 1), Chiang Mai, to
  immediately submit the proposal to the Governors of Chiang Mai And Chiang Rai provinces
  to prosecute the 4 COVID-19 infected person who smuggled into Thailand through natural
  crossing paths and did not follow the 14 day-quarantine measure according several Acts,
  especially the Communicable Diseases Act B.E. 2558 (2015)..
- The Ministry of Public Health together with the Ministry of Tourism and Sports steer the health tourism policy by creating new tourism routes in 4 regions with standard, comfortability, safety, cleanliness, excellent services and reasonable prices. The campaign aims to encourage Thais and foreigners to travel in the country after the COVID 19 crisis. The pilot event "Travel Thailand, Healthy Life, Local Ways of Living 2020" is ready to be held during 9 13 December 2020 in Bangkok.

#### 4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

Since October 2020, the COVID-19 confirmed cases have risen. Most of the cases were Thais found in state quarantine facilities coming from other continents including America, Europe, Africa and Asia. This corresponded to the rising of cases around the world. Moreover, cases were found among smugglers from Myanmar both in Chiang Mai and Chiang Rai provinces which corresponded with the rising cases of COVID-19 in Myanmar. Thus, the risk of finding these cases continues. Therefore, surveillance must be strengthened in patients with respiratory symptoms especially those with risk history. The risk communication to the public to maintain strict compliance with preventive measures including mask wearing, frequent hands washing, social distancing, and scanning of Thai Chana platform must be re-emphasized.
