### 3. Thailand Precautions

- The Ministry of Justice had reiterated to the Chiangmai Central Prison, Chiangrai Central Prison and nearby prisons to strictly comply with the standard disease prevention and control measures to strengthen screening of new prisoners. In addition, family visit must be forbidden until 31 December 2020.
- Nakhon Ratchasima province strengthened control of tourism in Khao Yai National Park through the temperature measurement points before entering the park and limitation of tourists who stay overnight not to be crowded. If a person is found with symptoms that meet the definition of COVID - 19, a rescue vehicle will be delivered the patient to Pak Chong Hospital. While the limited number of tourist to attend the Big Mountain concert during 12 - 13 December 2020 has also been ordered and the organizing agency must comply with preventive and control measures. If a patient or high-risk person is found, they will be sent to the hospital depending on the doctor's consideration.
- Chiang Rai province coordinated with the Myanmar local authorities, through the Thailand-Myanmar Township Border Committee (TBC), and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA)'s registration system to send approximately 400 Thai people in Tachileik township back through the official Point of Entry (POE). Meanwhile, various units in Mae-Sai district and Chiang-Saen district, Chiang-Rai province, mobilized workforces to prevent illegal immigration according to the Re X-ray measures against COVID-19 during 9 - 15 December 2020

### 4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

From the surveillance of travellers who stayed in the State Quarantine facilities in Thailand on December 12, 2020, 12 COVID-19 confirmed cases were detected. Among the 12 cases, 9 were Thais, 7 were from Bahrain and the rest were from Germany, Sweden, England, India, and Kuwait each. Two had the history of prior infection from abroad. For the current situation in Bahrain, the cumulative number of cases is 88,631 and 900 new cases as of this week starting from December 7, 2020. The trend of cases has been decreasing. However, there must still be a close monitoring of travellers departed from this country and the State Quarantine officers are required to strictly follow the self-protection measures.
