3. Thailand Precautions

- Commander of the 36th Ranger Forces Regiment, Mae-Hong-Son province, ordered its subordinate units in 3 southern zone districts of Mae-Hong-Son province, including Khun-Yuam district, Mae-Sariang district, and Sop-Moei district, to increase the strict patrols along the border to deter illegal escaping into the city and to establish screening points for the COVID-19.
- Deputy Governor of Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) and the concerned officials inspected the 4 types for business enterprises with the previous outbreaks of COVID-19 consisting of a boxing stadium, pub, bar and karaoke shop, during 9 - 15 December 2020 in order to create understanding and cooperation from the owners to strictly follow the preventive and control measures.

4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

From the monitoring of COVID-19 situation, it was found that as of 31 December 2020, there were 72.1 million COVID-19 confirmed cases and 1.61 million had died (2.23 % Case Fatality Rate). The highest cases were found in the United states (16.5 million cases or 22.66%), India (9.9 million cases or 13.68%), Brazil (6.9 million cases or 9.55%), and Russia (2.6 million cases or 3.64%). Thailand continues to find new confirmed cases in State Quarantine facilities) everyday. Therefore, the risk of bringing the COVID-19 into Thailand remains high. It is, therefore, an order to those who want to travel to Thailand to be quarantined at the designated places and refrain from illegally crossing the borders through natural border paths.
