3. Thailand Implementations

 Phayao Province provides vaccine services according to the Ministry of Public Health's COVID-19 vaccine distribution plan and strictly adheres to D-M-H-T-T-A measures. The second dose will be given to the elderly aged 60 years old, people with 7 diseases and the general public at 8 vaccine service centers where vaccination must be voluntary.

Public Health's measures in 5 issues as follows: 1. There will be temporarily closed checkpoint areas surrounding Mueang Nakhon Si Thammarat District 2. The community is closed in Nakhon Si Thammarat municipality 3. Special Operation Center has been established, using hotline 199 and telephone number 0-7534-8118 to receive notification of the situation of COVID-19 24 hours a day 4. Increase the number of field hospitals and waiting centers by private hospitals, private sectors, and the Thai Traditional Medicine Club supports and 5. Refrain or avoid traveling to the area where the epidemic is as well as allowing establishments and agencies to reduce risks and continually self-assessment.

• The Ministry of Education and the Department of Health allowed boarding schools to reopen during the COVID 19 situation. According to the operation guideline, the boarding school must apply to join the Sandbox Safety Zone in School model project and be able to organize a Hybrid teaching platform both on site and online.

4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

From the assessment of situation, comparing the number of severe COVID-19 cases and number of COVID-19 vaccination between 14 -28 September 2021 found that the coverage of COVID-19 vaccination both first and second dose was 31.88% (23.17-99.14) and 19.26% (11.67-74.38) respectively. On 28 September 2021, a total number of 3,232 severe cases were reported with the trend of reduced severe cases over the past 2 weeks. The number of severe cases reduced 53.70%, 63.64%, 80% and 100% in provinces where the coverage of COVID-19 vaccination is below 40%, 40-60%, 60-80% and over 80% respectively. The trend of using invasive ventilators is 62.96%, 63.64%, 80% and 100%. The increased coverage of COVID-19 vaccination led to the reduction of severe cases and invasive ventilator use. However, it is unable to conclude whether the second dose of COVID-19 vaccination will reduce the number of severe cases. In addition, most provinces have the coverage of second dose vaccination less than 40%. Therefore, it is needed to expedite and increase the COVID-19 vaccination coverage.
