### 3. Thailand Implementations

- Phetchabun Province is preparing to provide vaccination for all people in Phu Thap Boek area. The maximum control area has been established in Moo 14 and Moo 16 Wang Ban Subdistrict, Lom Kao District. People are not allowed to enter or leave between October 18 and October 31, 2021. Furthermore, hotel operators and resorts in the area do not accept any tourists who are allowed only to visit the area.

- The Governor of Yala Province, Chairman of the Provincial Committee of Communicable Disease, announced the measures to stimulate Covid-19 vaccination by seeking for cooperation from government agencies, state enterprises, local government organizations and all banks to provide services only to people who have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. All should present their certificate of vaccinations or certified documents in the Mor Prom application, or a sticker attached to the back of the ID card to confirm vaccination.
- The Ministry of Public Health and the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) are preparing to open the country by cooperating with related agencies including the Ministry of Tourism and Sports, Tourism Authority of Thailand, the Ministry of Interior, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand, Airports of Thailand PLC., Royal Thai Police, the Ministry of Digital Economy and Society, Provincial Communicable Disease Committee and Bangkok Communicable Disease Committee. The Ministry of Public Health has prepared 5 areas as follows 1. surveillance, prevention and control of disease. 2. Laboratory testing 3. Measures for COVID Free Setting 4. Adjustments of the medical treatment model to be consistent with the situation 5. Pharmaceuticals and logistics.

#### 4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

According to the COVID-19 situation monitoring, on 26 October 2021, Thailand has 1,866,863 accumulated confirmed cases, of which 7,706 new cases have been confirmed on the day, with 66 deaths. The daily infection continues to decline. However, when analyzing the situation of daily new infections by ATK method, the rate of daily new infections per total number of tests remained relatively stable. As a result, they can't be trusted about the decline in the number of infected people. The average daily incidence rate was 5 percent, down from September. In this regard, the Ministry of Public Health has given priority to speed up the immunization program for the population in the country as soon as possible, especially in the pilot areas for tourism. It is necessary to raise the immunity of the population to a high level. Still preventive measures are important in reducing the spread of the disease. Therefore, all should strictly wear a mask, keep their distance, wash hands, etc.
