### 3. Thailand Implementations

- The CCSA has considered allowing the organization of the Loy-Krathong activity, but people must strictly comply with COVID-19 prevention and control. In addition, the CCSA suggested that organizing the exhibit booth and meeting at the hotel or department store be implemented in accordance with the COVID-19-free setting recommended by the Ministry of Public Health.
- Chiang Rai Province focuses on six main measures of DMHT-RC, additional measures of SSET-CQ, vaccination in personnel/ students, and ATK test. It should anticipate a scenario of a new outbreak of the academic institute located in the main attraction of the Mae Chan district.

## 4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

According to the information of the Global COVID -19 situation, it found more than 252 million cumulative confirmed cases (more than 400,000 cases per day) and there was an increasing trend of new cases when compared to the number of mid - October due to the high number of cases in Europe. The majority of cases were reported from the United States, Germany, the United Kingdom and Russia. For the situation in ASEAN, the overall number of cases showed a decreasing trend. However, the outbreak remains high in Vietnam at more than 8,000 cases per day and there was no sign of decreasing its number.

Thailand had 1,968,106 cumulative confirmed cases, of which 7,496 new cases have been confirmed today. There was a decreasing trend of COVID -19 case in every part of Thailand (around 7,000 cases per day). While new confirmed cases were mostly found in the center and south of the country, particularly in Bangkok, Samut Prakan, Chonburi, Samut Sakhon and Nonthaburi. The total number of deaths was 19,789 cases (1.01%). The cases were mostly found in the elderly and people with underlying diseases who had no history of receiving the vaccine or were not fully vaccinated. For the vaccination rollout situation in Thailand, more than 82.5 million doses were inoculated among people with more than 35.2 million people who received 2 doses of vaccines. The provinces with the highest proportion of persons receiving two or more doses of vaccine were Bangkok, Phuket, and Chonburi. Most provinces still accounted for less than 50 percent of vaccinated people. Even though the rate of people received the vaccine was significantly increasing, the country is still at risk for the COVID -19 due to the reopening country policy and relaxing measures as well as the vaccine provided can prevent the severe symptom and death from the COVID -19, not prevent the transmission of the disease. In the meantime, it was expected that the number of new cases will decrease gradually this week at more than 6,000 cases per day), therefore, there was a need to make surveillance among patients with the suspected symptom, actively investigate the cluster outbreak in risk areas, and encourage people to lift their guide high by wearing a mask, always washing hands, implementing the work from the home policy as appropriate, refraining from visiting the risk areas or mass gathering places and getting the vaccine.
