### 3. Thailand Implementations

- The Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) is preparing to relax measures for entertainment venues in 17 “Blue Zone” provinces with the tourism destinations by applying a schedule opening and refraining from four activities, including no karaoke service, no communal dance area, refrain from serving any drinks with the same glass and refrain from engaging in promotional activities, providing personalized and close contact services to customers.
- Bang Sue Central Vaccination Center announced that from November 26, the center will switch their main vaccine to Pfizer and Moderna as a 1st, 2nd and 3rd dose, depending on what is available on the day. Those who insist on receiving the AstraZeneca and Sinovac vaccines must make a request before the appointment day.
- Foreign workers from 3 nationalities including Myanmar, Laos and Cambodia will be allowed by the Ministry of Labor to enter the country legally under the situation of COVID-19 spreading. It aims to help employers and establishments to have adequate workers in business running. The registration will be opened on December

1, 2021. However, they need to present their medical certificate showing the result of RT-PCR and ATK COVID-19 test (no more than 72 hours before departure) and vaccination certificate.

#### 4. Risk Assessment of COVID-19 Situation

From COVID-19 situation monitoring, on November 26, 2021, Thailand has 2,094,886 cumulative confirmed cases, of which 6,559 new cases have been confirmed on the day, and 64 deaths, most of which are from the High-risk groups who, when infected, are prone to become severely ill or die. In this regard, the Ministry of Public Health has given priority to the immunization of the population in the country as soon as possible, especially in tourism areas, which need to raise the immunity of the population to a high level, areas with high rates of new confirmed cases, and in the risk groups with the possibility of severe illness or death include the elderly aged 60 years and over, those with 7 chronic diseases, and pregnant women with gestational age of 12 weeks or more. Also, strictly comply to disease prevention measures, for example, wearing mask, keeping distance, and washing hand frequently is still important to reduce the spread of the disease.
